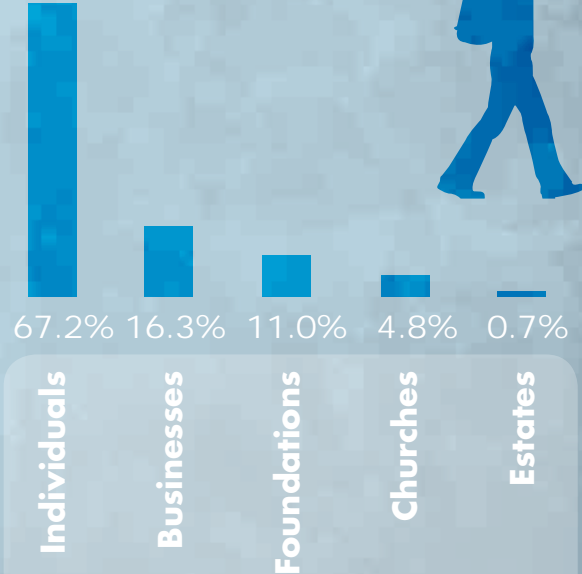

GREENVILLE

Miracle Hill Greenville Rescue Mission is a homeless shelter that provides beds for both men and families in need. Guests are provided with meals, clothing, use of laundry facilities, personal care items, daily devotionals, personal counseling, access to health and human services and GED fulfillment opportunities.

CHEROKEE COUNTY

Miracle Hill Rescue Mission • Cherokee County opened in 2000 to provide food, shelter and compassion for the hurting and the homeless in the area. The Mission operates in a Christian environment where residents can find hope and a future.



SPARTANBURG

Miracle Hill Rescue Mission • Spartanburg, is a homeless shelter that provides 68 beds for men and 32 for women and their children. It can also accommodate 50 additional people during extreme weather conditions. The mission provides food, shelter, discipleship, GED classes, counseling and assistance in finding work and housing.

SHEPHERD'S GATE

Miracle Hill Shepherd's Gate is a 56 bed emergency shelter for women and their children. Here, homeless, abused and needy women and their children can find shelter and safety. Shepherd's Gate serves these ladies through feeding, clothing and sheltering them, and by offering counsel and support.



RECOVERY MINISTRIES SUMMARY

The life of an addict is not easy to change. Many of our drug or alcohol-addicted clients lost their marriages, abandoned their children, or spent time in jail because they were not willing or able to adjust their lifestyles. However, our goal is to show these men and women a reason greater than themselves and their present circumstances to give up their destructive habits.

OVERCOMERS

Overcomers is a seven-month, residential, Christian recovery program that uses a Biblical adaptation of the 12-step recovery model for men suffering from life-dominating addictions. The program opened at a separate location in 2010 after moving out of Miracle Hill Greenville Rescue Mission.

RENEWAL

Through a focused educational curriculum, counseling, and individual work study, the Renewal program ensures that women overwhelmed by life-dominating problems such as addiction, lack of impulse control, or domestic violence can grow to live successfully and independently.

TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

Miracle Hill currently operates 11 transitional houses with 60 beds. Having sufficient transitional housing will enhance our ability to be successful in moving clients from the Renewal and Overcomers programs back into full independence.



RELIEF MINISTRY / FOOD WAREHOUSE

Miracle Hill's Relief Ministry strives to bring food and nourishment to the people in our facilities. Our staff works behind-the-scenes, planning and providing what goes along with serving the less fortunate, thereby being the hands and feet of Christ in a very tangible way.

CHILDREN'S HOME

Founded in 1957, Miracle Hill Children's Home in Pickens County serves abandoned, troubled, neglected and abused children from ages 4 to 21 and provides them with quality Christian care through five home-style cottages that are staffed with Youth Mentors. While here, they receive love and care while learning important life skills.

FOSTER CARE

Foster parents are ordinary people who recognize the unique needs of children in troubled family situations and are willing to make a meaningful difference by investing time, energy, love, and guidance into these precious lives. Through Miracle Hill, Christians, both single and married, have the opportunity to care for children and teens who are in need of a loving family environment.



BOYS' SHELTER

Miracle Hill Boys' Shelter cares for at-risk young men, ages 11-21, who are in emergency situations due to abuse and neglect. It provides a safe-haven for boys until they transition to their next placement or back to their homes. Many stay with us longer. The boys come through the Department of Social Services (DSS) for a variety of reasons.

HOMES FOR LIFE

Homes for Life was originated by a group of individuals with a heart for the 20,000 young adults who leave the foster care system with no family, completed education, or place to live. In order to minister to those who were raised in dysfunctional households or considered property of the state, the founders created Homes for Life and strived to demonstrate Christ-likeness and selflessness through their service.





THRIFT STORES / AUTO SALES
