## A Story Redeemed

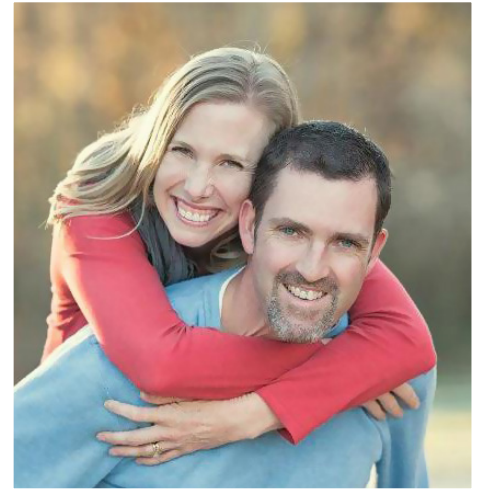
Before Toby came to Miracle Hill, he was completely hopeless. Addiction tore his life apart—he alienated everyone that loved him, grew to hate himself and even begged God to let him die. Though Toby considered himself a believer, he admits he was “a very confused follower of Christ.”

So once Toby arrived at Miracle Hill, he truly believed his story was irredeemable. He didn't have even the slightest hope that he could beat addiction and live a healthy, restored life. But Toby had already lost everything that mattered... Why not try out Miracle Hill?

One day, as Toby was sitting at a table in the Greenville Rescue Mission, he had a life-changing realization— “God could take your story of living under a bridge, or your story of sticking a needle in your arm until you wanted to die, or your story of being abandoned by your parents... and He can actually bring life out of it. He doesn't change the story, He changes the meaning of it. He gives it a different interpretation. He gives it life.” Though Toby had given up on himself, he finally realized that God never gave up on him... and never will.

Through the Rescue Mission and the Overcomers program, Toby surrendered his brokenness, addiction and past mistakes to the Father. “God's heart beats for the sick and sinful,” Toby declares, “and He pours His grace, truth and love into our wounds.” And even though he had a lot of knowledge about God, he needed practical steps to walk in the truth. His counselors at Overcomers guided him to *practice* the gospel he knew in his head. “That is true learning, according to the Scriptures.”

Once he graduated from the Overcomers program, Toby worked in one of Miracle Hill's thrift stores, and now serves as a counselor in the Rescue Mission he once called home. These days, Toby delights in sharing his story with the people he meets at Miracle Hill. “[I tell our clients] that they matter,” he shares, “that their stories matter... and that God is interested in redeeming their story—not re-writing it, but actually *using* every dark chapter for His glory, our good and the advancement of His kingdom.”

## Seeking God's Will for This New Year

*"But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you."* Matthew 6:33 - NKJV

During my first three months at Miracle Hill, I was often asked, "What will you change or do differently at Miracle Hill?" While it is common for many leaders who come into a new ministry to quickly share their ideas and vision, I do not consider that a wise path. God has blessed Miracle Hill with many amazing leaders. We see so many changed lives in our children and adults each year through the current infrastructure that it would be unwise to make any major changes early in my leadership. God has grown this ministry so that it impacts thousands of people every year. As we seek His will first, the Lord will continue to guide us.

God is clearly guiding us to invest more in children. Our foster care and family strengthening programs are our fastest growing ministries. Three years ago, we had 45 children in our foster care program. In late 2015, we reached 127 foster families. God has really grown our faith in recent months as we needed to spend \$45,000 each month to support our foster care program. Sometime in 2016, we will pass our goal of 200 Miracle Hill foster families, which is about 20% of the foster care homes needed in South

Carolina. Our foster care ministry is our strategy to prevent more children from becoming homeless, addicts, or both. We have trained staff who work with their birth parents, whenever possible, to give each family a chance to be reunited. If reunification is not possible, we help provide a path for them to have a safe home where they can hear about Christ's love.

As we begin our New Year, please pray for the children and adults in our care, along with our staff who tirelessly serve on their behalf. As you pray, always ask God how He would have you serve or give in the future. Every gift makes a difference. But your best goal for this New Year should be to seek His will first in all of your decisions!

## The Steps of a Good Man



Growing up, Winston never knew his father. He lived only under the care of his mother, but she was overcome by a crippling addiction to drugs. When Winston was removed from his home due to neglect, he lived in foster homes as well as the Miracle Hill Children's Home before finally arriving at the Boys' Shelter. As we got to know Winston, we saw that he was a scared young man who also struggled with following expectations and living within a structured home environment. He had never been held accountable for his actions, but for the first time he was ready to step into something better.

When he came to Miracle Hill, Winston learned basic responsibilities like cooking, cleaning and washing clothes. He was also able to graduate from high school

and enroll in college through the training program at the shelter. Most importantly, Winston came to know the Lord one year ago, when he cried out to God for help and heard Him say, "I'm here for you, son." Winston recently told the staff that because Miracle Hill is a Christian organization and a safe haven for him, he has learned how to be a kind, productive young man. Several local churches have also come alongside of Winston and encouraged him to see himself the way Christ does.

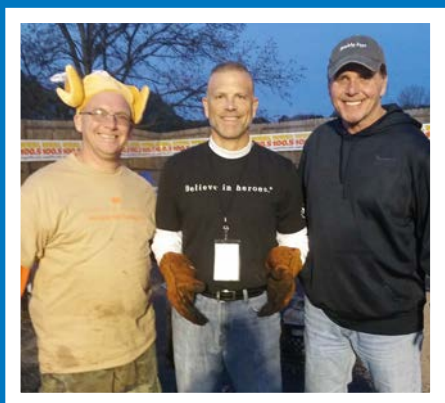
Now, Winston is 19 years old, working a full-time job, and transitioning to college over the next few months. As he has grown as a man and a believer, he stopped being defined by the pain and neglect of his past.
