they were 5 and 7 along with their two sisters. Their case was long and complicated. For four years Mark* prayed nightly that he would be able to go home to a Christian foster/adoptive family and that all his siblings could stay together. Currently, Miracle Hill has just over 200 foster families across the Upstate. Because we want to provide them with the best support possible, we created **Fostersphere**. she believed she could not get a job - she had not worked for years. We asked her to help a bit in the kitchen. She did and she felt useful! Sue* is now working and her face just glows. She proved that she does have the ability to have a stable life and live independently.
