

General Information for Overcomer Applicants

APPLICATION PROCESS

All applicants must complete an application or the Overcomer application. Applications must be submitted online, mailed, faxed, or delivered to our office.

All applicants must be interviewed as part of the admission process. Interviews are held at the Overcomers Center whenever possible, phone interviews are done under certain circumstances.

If accepted, an admission date and time will be **assigned**. Admissions are done Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 am and 3:00 pm, any exceptions **must** have staff approval.

DRUG SCREENS

Admission is conditional based upon the applicant's ability to pass a drug screen and Breathalyzer test. This is not a detox center. It is the applicant's responsibility to arrange entry into a local detox center or have medical supervision through the detox process.

MEDICATIONS

All medications must be listed on the application as well as any physical conditions. Medical conditions should be supported by diagnosis of a physician or through medical records.

Applicant must bring all medications (30 day supply) along with prescriptions. Applicant is responsible for obtaining all medications as Overcomers is unable to assume this responsibility.

Overcomers does not permit anti-anxiety medications, prescription pain medications or sleep aids. Medications considered to be mental health related must be prescribed by a Psychiatrist and are otherwise not acceptable.

ID & SOCIAL SECURITY CARD

Applicant **must** bring his DMV issued Driver's license or ID as well as his Social Security Card at the time of admission.

LEGAL

If you have legal obligations of any kind, you must provide us written permission from the ruling agency prior to enrollment into the Overcomers Program. We are unable to get applicants released from detention.

WORK

Residents are not allowed to hold employment while here. Overcomers is a restricted program.

RELIGIOUS AFFILIATION

Overcomers is a non denominational program, but conservative in nature.
