

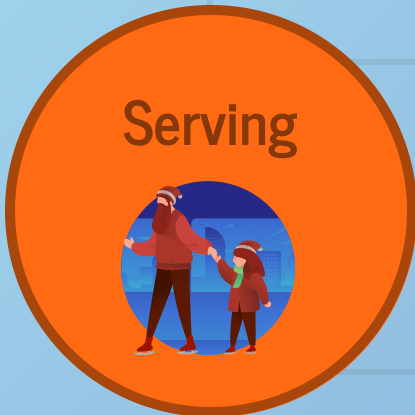
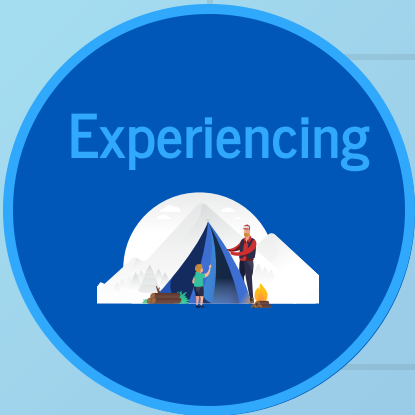
BACKYARD MISSIONS



Backyard Missions is a tool to inspire families and the church to learn more about homelessness and addiction that is taking place right here in their own community. It gives children a chance to serve Miracle Hill and our guests alongside their families or church. The program has three sections: Learning, Experiencing, and Serving. Each section helps children understand the difficulties of those persons experiencing homelessness and understand how Miracle Hill helps.

This is the single day option for churches, youth groups, or other groups wanting to complete Backyard Missions in a one day.
