Miracle Hill is inviting the public to donate frozen turkeys. Donations may be dropped off Friday, November 11th from 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm and Saturday, November 12th, from 10:00 am-2:00 pm at either the Food Warehouse (725 Keith Drive, Greenville, SC) or to the Spartanburg Rescue Mission (189 N Forest Drive, Spartanburg, SC.) Donors may also purchase items from an Amazon Wish List and have them shipped directly to the ministry. Financial contributions can be made through miraclehill.org, to help provide for the ongoing care of the guests living in the shelters.

Thanksgiving dinners will be provided at Miracle Hill's four homeless shelters and two recovery programs, and turkeys will be distributed to Miracle Hill foster families. Miracle Hill is also partnering with several community ministries and organizations in Greenville and Spartanburg Counties with the goal of distributing meals to low-income neighborhoods and additional people in need.
